Profile of Graduate Students Fall 2012 and Fall 2013

This report contains demographic and academic information for graduate students in Fall 2012 and Fall 2013. Information¹ is included on:

Fall 2013

The graduate student enrollment of 739 includes 290 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2013 or Fall 2013. Demographically, seventy-three percent (539) of the graduate students are female, and more than sixty percent (469) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up thirty percent of the group. Ninety-three percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Forty-two percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. The three largest graduate programs are the Master of Education, Master of Arts in Psychology, and the Master of Business Administration, with approximately 30%, 18%, and 15% of all graduate students, respectively.

Fall 2012

The graduate student enrollment of 537 includes 273 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2012 or Fall 2012. Demographically, seventy-four percent (399) of the graduate students are female, and more than sixty percent (327) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-eight percent of the group. Ninety-three percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Forty-three percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. The three largest graduate programs are the Master of Education, Master of Business Administration, and the Master of Arts in Psychology, with approximately 36%, 14%, and 14% of all graduate students, respectively.
