Fall 2017

The transfer students of Fall 2017 included 235 students who entered the University in Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. Demographically, seventy-two percent (169) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty-two percent (146) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nineteen percent (44) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 214 (91.1%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Seventy-one percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 15% coming from an in-state four year institution and 56% from an in-state two year school.

Thirty-five percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 6.4% declared Psychology.

Fall 2016

The transfer students of Fall 2016 included 236 students who entered the University in Summer 2016 or Fall 2016. Demographically, sixty-eight percent (161) of the new transfer students were female, and sixty-six percent (157) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up twenty-one percent (49) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 222 (94.1%) had Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety percent of the students were U.S. citizens. Sixty-seven percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 16% coming from an in-state four year institution and 51% from an in-state two year school.

Forty-three percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 8.5% declared Biology and 4.2% declared Psychology.
