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Profile of Graduate Students Fall 2016 and Fall 2017

Fall 2017

The graduate student enrollment of 1,009 includes 329 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2017 or Fall 2017. Demographically, seventy-two percent (722) of the graduate students are female, and more than sixty percent (630) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-two percent of the group. Eighty-eight percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Thirty-seven percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Nearly thirteen percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Counseling, the MA in Psychology, and the Master of Business Administration.

Fall 2016

The graduate student enrollment of 938 included 329 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2016 or Fall 2016. Demographically, sixty-nine percent (648) of the graduate students were female, and more than sixty percent (579) were from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation made up twenty-nine percent of the group. Ninety percent of the students were U.S. citizens.

Thirty-three percent of the graduate students were classified as full-time. The three largest graduate programs were the Master of Business Administration, the MA in Counseling, and the MA in Psychology.
