#### Fall 2019

The freshmen class of Fall 2019 includes 727 students who entered the University in Summer 2019 or Fall 2019. Demographically, sixty-five percent (471) of the new freshmen are female, and 82.8% (602) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 21.7% of the group, an increase from last year.

For students with known addresses, 698 (96.0%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 53 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 78.1% of the class, an increase over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, fifty-seven percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1110 for the redesigned SAT and 22 for the ACT examination. Twenty-one percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 15 percent were Biology.

#### Fall 2018

The freshmen class of Fall 2018 includes 531 students who entered the University in Summer 2018 or Fall 2018. Demographically, just over two-thirds (359) of the new freshmen are female, and 71.8% (381) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 20.0% of the group, a decrease from last year.

For students with known addresses, 507 (95.5%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 41 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 77.9% of the class, a decrease increase over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, fifty-four percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1118 for the redesigned SAT and 23 for the ACT examination. Twenty percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 4 percent were undecided.

### **Test Score Calculations**

For students with both an SAT and ACT score, both scores are reported. Additionally, for students with multiple SAT test scores, the highest verbal and math subscores (from any test date) are added to get the student's final SAT score. For Fall 2006, this procedure resulted in an increase of approximately 6 points on the average SAT score, from 1074 to 1080.

Prior to Fall 2007, SAT scores were reported using Recruitment PLUS. Recruitment PLUS converted all ACT scores to an equivalent SAT score, and included the converted scores in the final mean.
