Fall 2019

The transfer students of Fall 2019 included 268 students who entered the University in Summer 2019 or Fall 2019. Demographically, nearly sixty-eight percent (181) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty-five percent (175) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up twenty-two percent (59) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 242 (90.3%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Eighty-six percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Seventy-two percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 14% coming from an in-state four year institution and 58% from an in-state two year school.

Thirty-four percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while twelve percent declared Psychology.

Fall 2018

The transfer students of Fall 2018 included 263 students who entered the University in Summer 2018 or Fall 2018. Demographically, nearly sixty percent (153) of the new transfer students are female, and fifty-eight percent (152) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nineteen percent (49) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 226 (85.9%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Seventy-one percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 15% coming from an in-state four year institution and 56% from an in-state two year school.

Twenty-eight percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while ten percent declared Interdisciplinary Studies.
