Fall 2021

The freshmen class of Fall 2021 includes 802 students who entered the University in Summer 2021 or Fall 2021. Demographically, sixty-three percent (506) of the new freshmen are female, and 82.2% (659) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 18.2% of the group, an increase from last year.

For students with known addresses, 748 (93.3%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 56 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 76.4% of the class, a decrease over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, fifty-one percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1144 for the redesigned SAT and 25 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Twenty percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 11 percent were Biology.

Fall 2022

The freshmen class of Fall 2022 includes 732 students who entered the University in Summer 2022 or Fall 2022. Demographically, sixty-one percent (445) of the new freshmen are female, and 81.7% (598) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 19.7% of the group, an increase from last year.

For students with known addresses, 667 (91.1%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 59 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 74.4% of the class, a decrease over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-five percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1151 for the redesigned SAT and 24 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Seventeen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 11 percent were Psychology.

Test Score Calculations

For students with both an SAT and ACT score, both scores are reported. Additionally, for students with multiple SAT test scores, the highest verbal and math subscores (from any test date) are added to get the student's final SAT score. For Fall 2006, this procedure resulted in an increase of approximately 6 points on the average SAT score, from 1074 to 1080.

Prior to Fall 2007, SAT scores were reported using Recruitment PLUS. Recruitment PLUS converted all ACT scores to an equivalent SAT score, and included the converted scores in the final mean.
