Fall 2022

The freshmen class of Fall 2022 includes 732 students who entered the University in Summer 2022 or Fall 2022. Demographically, sixty-one percent (445) of the new freshmen are female, and 81.7% (598) are from racial or ethnic minority groups.

Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 19.7% of the group, an increase from last year. For students with known addresses, 667 (91.1%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 59 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 74.4% of the class, a decrease over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-five percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1151 for the redesigned SAT and 24 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Seventeen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while 11 percent were Psychology.

Fall 2023

The freshmen class entering in Fall 2023 includes 729 students who began their studies at the University over the preceding summer and fall academic terms. Demographically, 60.1% (438 students) are female and 76.8% (560) belong to an ethnic or racial minority group.

Students affiliating with the Baptist religious faith continue to make up the largest share at 18.0% of the cohort. Geographically, 675 freshmen (92.6%) provide a Texas permanent address covering 65 counties. However, the combined share from Harris, Fort Bend and Dallas counties fell slightly to 74.3%. Among students reporting high school class rank, 43.6% placed in the top quartile academically. SAT critical reading and math mean scores rose to 1175 composite, while average ACT results climbed to 26 composite for those submitting traditional test score applications.

Nursing remains the most popular major at 18.7%, trailed distantly by Biology and Business Administration. Compared to last year's entering group, minority enrollment, top high school student representation and choice of Psychology major decreased noticeably, partially offset by small improvements in academic metrics and greater preference for Nursing studies.
