Profile of Graduate Students Fall 2022 and Fall 2023

This report contains demographic and academic information for Graduate students who entered the University in Fall 2022 and Fall 2023. Information is included on:

Fall 2022

The graduate student enrollment of 1,434 includes 503 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2022 or Fall 2022. Demographically, seventy-five percent (1,087) of the graduate students are female, and 68.1% (976) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up thirteen percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Thirteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Fifty-seven percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Psychology, the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, and the MS in Nursing.

Fall 2023

The graduate student enrollment of 1,402 includes 424 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2023 or Fall 2023. Demographically, seventy-four percent (1,030) of the graduate students are female, and 64% (894) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up ten percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Sixteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Fifty-six percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs.

The three largest graduate programs continue to be the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, the MA in Psychology, and the Executive EdD in Mental Health/Human Services.

In summary, while overall graduate enrollment decreased slightly between Fall 2022 and Fall 2023, the majority demographic and academic program profiles remain largely consistent over the past three years. Notable changes are the drop in both minority student and Baptist student representation, as well as growth in the Executive Mental Health/Human Services doctoral program. The proportion of full-time and 100% online students increased slightly.
