Fall 2022

The transfer students of Fall 2022 included 273 students who entered the University in Summer 2022 or Fall 2022. Demographically, nearly sixty-one percent (166) of the new transfer students are female, and sixty-six percent (180) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up eighteen percent (48) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 238 (87.2%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety-three percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Seventy-one percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 17% coming from an in-state four year institution and 54% from an in-state two year school.

Eighteen percent of students declared a major in Psychology, while ten percent declared Nursing.

Fall 2023

The transfer students of Fall 2023 included 239 students who entered the University in Summer 2023 or Fall 2023. Demographically, just over half (136 students, 57%) of the new transfers are female, representing a drop compared to last year.

The proportion of racial or ethnic minority students increased slightly to 69% (165 students). Students with a Baptist religious affiliation now make up 14% (33 students) of transfer students, down notably from 18% last year. For students with known addresses, 194 (81%) have Texas as their state of permanent residence compared to 87% last year. The vast majority, 98% of transfers are U.S. citizens.

Looking at prior colleges, 44% transferred from a Texas two-year institution, down 10 percentage points from last year's 54%.

Psychology remains the most popular major at 17% of declared majors, followed by Nursing and Biblical Studies. Interdisciplinary Studies and the Bachelor of Arts degree program also attracted sizable numbers of transfer students this year. The proportion enrolling as full-time students increased to 56%, up from 48% last year.
