Fall 2024

The freshmen class of Fall 2024 includes 751 students who entered the University in Summer 2024 or Fall 2024. Demographically, fifty-seven percent (426) of the new freshmen are female, and 81.2% (610) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 15.3% of the group, a decrease from last year.

For students with known addresses, 682 (90.8%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 56 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 76.6% of the class, a very slight increase over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-seven percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1089 for the redesigned SAT and 21 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Fourteen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while just over seven percent were Computer Science, and just under seven percent were Psychology.

Fall 2023

The freshmen class of Fall 2023 includes 727 students who entered the University in Summer 2023 or Fall 2023. Demographically, sixty percent (437) of the new freshmen are female, and 76.9% (559) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 18.0% of the group.

For students with known addresses, 687 (94.5%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 56 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 76.5% of the class.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-three percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1083 for the redesigned SAT and 23 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Eighteen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, seven percent were Psychology, and just under seven percent were Biochemistry/Molecular Biology.

Test Score Calculations

For students with both an SAT and ACT score, both scores are reported. Additionally, for students with multiple SAT test scores, the highest verbal and math subscores (from any test date) are added to get the student's final SAT score. For Fall 2006, this procedure resulted in an increase of approximately 6 points on the average SAT score, from 1074 to 1080.

Prior to Fall 2007, SAT scores were reported using Recruitment PLUS. Recruitment PLUS converted all ACT scores to an equivalent SAT score, and included the converted scores in the final mean.

1. During census processing, it was discovered that race/ethnicity and religious preference data were not being collected for online students. Efforts are underway to collect this data from students who are missing, but this missing data will skew the totals for populations with a large percentage of online students.
