Data is presented for transfer students by Main Campus (page 2), Online (page 13), and Total class (page 24). Data in the narrative below is for the Total class, both Main Campus and Online.

Fall 2024

The transfer students of Fall 2024 included 291 students who entered the University in Summer 2024 or Fall 2024. Demographically, fifty-six percent (163) of the new transfer students are female, and forty-eight percent (140) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up eleven percent (31) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 229 (78.7%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety-three percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Fifty-seven percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 14.8% coming from an in-state four year institution and 42.6% from an in-state two year school.

Eighteen percent of transfer students declared a major in Psychology, while eleven percent declared Interdisciplinary Studies-Non Education, and nine percent Business Administration.

Fall 2023

The transfer students of Fall 2023 included 238 students who entered the University in Summer 2023 or Fall 2023. Demographically, nearly fifty-seven percent (135) of the new transfer students are female, and fifty-four percent (128) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up fourteen percent (33) of the group.

For students with known addresses, 193 (81.1%) have Texas as their state of permanent address. Ninety-eight percent of the students are U.S. citizens. Sixty-three percent transferred from Texas colleges, with 19% coming from an in-state four year institution and 44% from an in-state two year school.

Seventeen percent of transfer students declared a major in Psychology, while thirteen percent declared Interdisciplinary Studies-Non Education, seven percent Business Administration, and another seven percent Nursing.

1. During census processing, it was discovered that race/ethnicity and religious preference data were not being collected for online students. Efforts are underway to collect this data from students who are missing, but this missing data will skew the totals for populations with a large percentage of online students.
