Data is presented for first-time freshmen by Main Campus (page 3), Online (page 17), and Total class (page 28). Data in the narrative below is for the Total class, both Main Campus and Online.

### Fall 2025

The freshmen class of Fall 2025 includes 1,001 students who entered the University in Summer 2025 or Fall 2025. Demographically, fifty-three percent (533) of the new freshmen are female, and 84.5% (846) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 12.8% of the group, a decrease from last year.

For students with known addresses, 935 (93.4%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 54 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 82.5% of the class, an increase over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-six percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1084 for the redesigned SAT and 23 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Sixteen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while just over fourteen percent were Electrical Engineering, and just over six percent were Computer Science.

### Fall 2024

The freshmen class of Fall 2024 includes 751 students who entered the University in Summer 2024 or Fall 2024. Demographically, fifty-seven percent (426) of the new freshmen are female, and 81.2% (610) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up 15.3% of the group, a decrease from last year.

For students with known addresses, 682 (90.8%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 56 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 76.6% of the class, a very slight increase over last year.

Among students who reported a high school class ranking, forty-seven percent were in the top quartile of their high school graduating classes. The class had a mean score of 1089 for the redesigned SAT and 21 for the ACT examination for those who chose to apply traditionally. Fourteen percent of students declared a major in Nursing, while just over seven percent were Computer Science, and just under seven percent were Psychology.

### **Test Score Calculations**

For students with both an SAT and ACT score, both scores are reported. Additionally, for students with multiple SAT test scores, the highest verbal and math subscores (from any test date) are added to get the student's final SAT score. For Fall 2006, this procedure resulted in an increase of approximately 6 points on the average SAT score, from 1074 to 1080.

Prior to Fall 2007, SAT scores were reported using Recruitment PLUS. Recruitment PLUS converted all ACT scores to an equivalent SAT score, and included the converted scores in the final mean.

1. During census processing for Fall 2024, it was discovered that race/ethnicity and religious preference data were not being collected for online students. Efforts were made to collect this data from students who were missing, but this missing data will skew the totals for populations with a large percentage of online students.
