Data is presented for undergraduate students by Main Campus (page 2), Online (page 16), and Total class (page 26). Data in the narrative below is for the Total class, both Main Campus and Online.

Fall 2025

The undergraduate enrollment of 3,277 includes 1,001 new freshmen and 286 new transfer students for Fall 2025. Demographically, fifty-seven percent (1,856) of the undergraduates are female, and 77.1% (2,527) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up fourteen percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,980 (91%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 99 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 80.2% of undergraduates.

Approximately 13% of undergraduates have declared a major in Nursing, while an additional 10% have declared Psychology and seven percent Electrical Engineering.

Fall 2024

The undergraduate enrollment of 2,899 includes 751 new freshmen and 291 new transfer students for Fall 2024. Demographically, fifty-nine percent (1,717) of the undergraduates are female, and 73.5% (2,131) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up sixteen percent of undergraduates.

For students with known addresses, 2,639 (91.02%) have Texas as their state of permanent address, representing 92 counties. Students from Harris, Fort Bend, and Brazoria counties make up 77.6% of undergraduates.

Approximately 13% of undergraduates have declared a major in Psychology, while an additional 12% have declared Nursing and six percent Biology.

1. During census processing for Fall 2024, it was discovered that race/ethnicity and religious preference data were not being collected for online students. Efforts were made to collect this data from students who were missing, but this missing data will skew the totals for populations with a large percentage of online students.
