

## **Profile of Graduate Students Fall 2024 and Fall 2025**

### **Fall 2025**

The graduate student enrollment of 1,416 includes 404 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2025 or Fall 2025. Demographically, seventy-four percent (1,041) of the graduate students are female, and 53% (751) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up eight percent of the group. Ninety-one percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Twelve percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Sixty-three percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, the MA in Psychology, and the Doctor of Education in Executive Mental Health/Human Services.

### **Fall 2024**

The graduate student enrollment of 1,377 includes 412 students who entered the University as new Graduate Students in Summer 2024 or Fall 2024. Demographically, seventy-three percent (1,005) of the graduate students are female, and 49.7% (685) are from racial or ethnic minority groups. Students with a Baptist religious affiliation make up nine percent of the group. Ninety-two percent of the students are U.S. citizens.

Thirteen percent of the graduate students are classified as full-time. Fifty-eight percent are enrolled in 100% Online programs. The three largest graduate programs are the MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling, the Doctor of Education in Executive Mental Health/Human Services, and the MA in Psychology.

1. Most graduate students list their local address as their permanent address, so state and county information is not included as in the other profiles.
2. During census processing for Fall 2024, it was discovered that race/ethnicity and religious preference data were not being collected for online students. Efforts were made to collect this data from students who were missing, but this missing data will skew the totals for populations with a large percentage of online students.
