# ASAP: GET YOUR HUSKY ID AND USERNAME

The first part of your email address is your username (before (dhbu.edu). This is usually your last name and first initial (e.g., lastnamef). If you forgot your username, please contact the ITS HelpDesk at HC.edu/HelpDesk or 281-649-3410 and answer the security questions.

If you forgot your password, visit LetMeIn.hbu.edu.

## **ASAP: FAFSA AND FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION**

- By March 1 submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.ed.gov and should be submitted to HCU using our school code 003576. Even if you think you are not likely to qualify for need-based aid, it's still a good idea to apply.
- If you complete your FAFSA to HCU, you'll receive a financial aid notification which will direct you to view and accept your financial aid package on Huskynet. **huskynetsso.hbu.edu**

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# **BY MAY 1: SECURE YOUR SPOT IN THE CLASS**

Confirm your enrollment with a \$200 deposit, paid with a credit or debit card. It will be applied to your student account. **HC.edu/deposit** 



# **REVIEW YOUR HOUSING OPTIONS**

- Housing applications will be sent on March 1.
- You are eligible to receive a housing application after you satisfy the **\$200** admission enrollment deposit.
- All freshmen are required to live on-campus their first year, and pay a \$150.00 housing deposit. More details?

# **REGISTER FOR "GO" GET ORIENTED SESSION**

- Registration for orientation starts March 1 if you are admitted for the fall term, or in November if you are admitted for the spring term. You can also learn more about "GO" dates and other topics here: **HC.edu/go**

# SUBMIT BACTERIAL MENINGITIS

Per Texas law, all students under the age of 22 who are attending a new college after January 1, 2014, must have received the meningitis vaccination no more than 5 years prior to the first day of class. Proof of vaccination must be submitted and on file with HCU. In addition, you must have received the vaccination at least 10 days prior to the start of class or campus movein in order to be on campus. **HC.edu/meningitis**

All offers of admission are tentative until the Office of Admissions receives your final high school and/or college transcripts. You must make arrangements to send your final high school and college transcripts to our office no later than August 1.
