Passport 1: EPP requirements

- 1. Meet the university requirements for admission
- 2. Overall GPA of 2.5
- 3. Hold a valid principal certification
- 4. EPP Interview
- 5. Current resume
- 6. 3 professional references
- 7. Successfully complete EPP paperwork

Passport 2: Degree Plan Delivery

- 1. Complete EPP acceptance process and paperwork
- 2. Meet with the advisor and sign the degree plan.
- 3. Enroll in courses approved by your advisor.
- 4. Program delivery includes 20-3 hour courses and 1-3 hours course of field experience, including proposal defense and dissertation defense.
- 5. Complete all required TAC trainings and assessments for the program.
- 6. Apply for graduation one year prior to its occurrence.

Passport 3: Internship/Certification

- 1. Enroll in Field Experience course (EDSU 7306)
- 2. Must have completed 12 hours of Leadership Core Courses.
- 3. The Field Experience will take place in the student's current district with a site mentor/supervisor that has current superintendent certification credentials.
- 4. Students will continue to work in their current position while they complete the field experience.
- 5. Field experience to include 160 logged hours of TEA "in the field" administrative experiences and TExES 195 certification preparation.
- 6. Confirm all required trainings are completed and certificates uploaded in Chalk & Wire.
- 7. Complete all HBU requirements for graduation, including a portfolio, a successful proposal defense, and a successful dissertation defense.
- 8. Completion of program statement by university supervisor and district site mentor/supervisor turned into the EPP office.
