

Job Description: HBU Embark is a week-long program designed to equip college-bound students to defend their faith and grow in their personal, spiritual, and social lives. Embark mentors are assigned a cohort of freshmen, host a small group daily, stay overnight in the dorms, and participate in all activities and off-campus excursions.

Compensation: \$500 stipend after program

**Job Responsibilities:**

- Ability to mentor and guide incoming freshmen
- Display a leadership role during activities and on excursions
- Work closely with HBU Embark staff to ensure the program runs smoothly
- Support staff/faculty and model appropriate behavior
- Use critical thinking and place student wellness at the forefront of all interactions
- Sleep overnight in the HBU residence halls
- Assist in planning and coordinating program activities
- Host daily small group with attendees over apologetics and college preparedness topics
- Participate in all weekly activities

Position Requirements: The desired candidate will be intentional, organized, and able to make authentic connections; adherence to HBU Code of Conduct and remain in good standing at the university; articulation of Christian faith required
