

Job Description: Husky STEPS is an immersive 5-day STEM summer bridge program. Husky STEPS is designed to help students successfully transition to the rigor of STEM academics by providing STEM specific workshops in math, science, engineering, study skills, and more. With a focus on math remediation, students will build analytical and critical thinking skills necessary to succeed in college level math. The program will also teach students more about life on campus and help build community.

Mandatory Dates:

- Husky Steps Program: July 9th- July 14th
- Husky Steps Spring Training: 4:00 pm - 6: 00 pm, April 12th
- Mentor Training: July 8th

Compensation: \$500 stipend after program

Job Responsibilities:

- Ability to mentor and guide incoming freshmen
- Display a leadership role during activities and on excursions
- Work closely with Husky Steps' staff and faculty to ensure the program runs smoothly
- Support staff/faculty and model appropriate behavior
- Use critical thinking and place student wellness at the forefront of all interactions
- Sleep overnight in the HBU residence halls
- Assist in planning and coordinating program activities
- Host daily small group with attendees
- Participate in all weekly activities

Position Requirements: The desired candidate will be intentional, organized, and able to make authentic connections; maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA (3.0 preferred); adherence to HBU Code of Conduct and remain in good standing at the university; preference is given to students who have previously attended Husky Steps.
