

Summer Launch Mentor

Job Description: Summer Launch is a week-long program designed to prepare incoming freshmen for the academic, social, and cultural rigors of college life. Summer Launch mentors are assigned a cohort of freshmen, host a small group daily, stay overnight in the dorms, and participate in all activities and off-campus excursions.

Mandatory Dates:

- Summer Launch Program: July 10th- July 14th
- Summer Launch Spring Training: 4:00 pm - 6: 00 pm, April 12th
- Mentor Training: July 9th

Compensation: \$500 stipend after program

Job Responsibilities:

- Ability to mentor and guide incoming freshmen
- Display a leadership role during activities and on excursions
- Work closely with Summer Lunch staff to ensure the program runs smoothly
- Support staff/faculty and model appropriate behavior
- Use critical thinking and place student wellness at the forefront of all interactions
- Sleep overnight in the HBU residence halls
- Assist in planning and coordinating program activities
- Host daily small group with attendees
- Participate in all weekly activities

Position Requirements: The desired candidate will be intentional, organized, and able to make authentic connections; maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA (3.0 preferred); adherence to HBU Code of Conduct and remain in good standing at the university; preference is given to students who have previously attended Summer Launch
