Sled Team Responsibilities

Qualifications: A Sled Team member must:

- Maintain a 2.5 GPA
- Be an enrolled student
- Go through the Sled Team Interview Process
- Commit to the Sled Team responsibilities listed below
- Remain in good standing with HCU (academics and conduct)

Duties & Responsibilities: Sled Team members or "Mushers" must:

- Walk Wakiza at least one scheduled hour per week
 - Can be split into two 30-minute sessions
 - Members are allowed to walk her more, if they desire.
 - Mushers must clean up after Wakiza (bags will be provided)
- Accompany Wakiza to at least two event appearances per month
 - Includes sporting events, recruitment events, and requested appearances
 - Be able to speak at certain events where needed on behalf of the Sled Team (scripts may be provided)
- Be committed to remain on the team for duration of admittance at HCU; unless asked to step down.
 - *Because Kiza is a live animal it is hard to continue to introduce her to multiple "care-givers." Our Sled Team remaining as consistent as possible is our goal.
- Attend all Sled Team Meetings, trainings, and special events:
 - Bi-weekly meetings to schedule above-mentioned appearances
 - Special training sessions with Wakiza and trainer, etc.
- Assist the Head Musher with needed care of Wakiza
 - Maintaining Wakiza's diet and treat consumption
 - Maintaining training commands and practices
 - Assisting with outings if needed (grooming, vet visits, etc.--- rare occasions)
- Be active in Wakiza's social media presence
 - Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat
 - During each walk posting on one or more of the social media platforms
