

Houston Christian University Mascot and Entourage Descriptions and Roles

As a grant funded student employee of HCU Student Life you are required to uphold the standards set in place by Houston Christian University and Student Life staff. Your job as a student worker is to effectively manage and maintain equipment, services, programs, and client relations in a manner of professionalism that represents all parties to the best of your ability.

Mascot Opportunities:

- **Suited Mascot/Mingo:** As the suited mascot (Mingo) for HCU this role is high visibility and requires absolute professionalism at all times. Responsibilities include but are not limited to:
 - Suit care and maintenance
 - Establishing and maintaining good relationships with clients, staff, coworkers, and the general public
 - Initiating contact with event managers before appearances and coordinating on site changing facilities as well as any changes from the initial request form that they are wanting
 - Reporting to the mascot manager on how events went and/or any issues that arose
 - Arrive at assigned events timely and ready to change
 - Provide opportunities for photos and interactions to the intended clients at assigned events
 - Ensure care of guests during interactions while in costume
 - Maintain the client and public experience by ensuring that Mingo is only ever seen in public fully ready and prepared for public interactions
 - Engage the public as “Mingo”, in character, and attentive to the role
- **Mascot/Mingo Entourage:** As the entourage for Mingo this role is high visibility and requires absolute professionalism at all times. Responsibilities include but are not limited to:
 - Suit care and maintenance
 - Establishing and maintaining good relationships with clients, staff, coworkers, and the general public
 - Initiating contact with event managers before appearances and coordinating on site changing facilities as well as any changes from the initial request form that they are wanting
 - Reporting to the mascot manager on how events went and/or any issues that arose
 - Arrive at assigned events timely and ready to change
 - Provide opportunities for photos and interactions to the intended clients at assigned events
 - Maintain the client and public experience by ensuring that Mingo is only ever seen in public fully ready and prepared for public interactions
 - Assist “Mingo” with costume changes as needed
 - Assist the general public and clients with photo opportunities and other interactions
 - Assist “Mingo” with general navigation at assigned appearances
 - Manage public interactions with Mingo to ensure a quality experience and provide for the safety of all individuals interacting with Mingo as well as the person in costume
 - Ensure that the individual in the Mingo costume is well cared for and provided with any needs as well as monitored for any kind of discomfort or distress
