



Graduate Assistant: Campus Recreation

Purpose/Objective:

The Grad Assistantship: Campus Recreation (GACR) position will serve under the department of Student Life with direct supervision from the Student Success Specialist for Student Engagement. This position is designed to provide higher ed experience in campus recreation and administration. The GACR will help develop campus recreation opportunities from intramurals to recreation programming.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide at least 12 hours per week to campus recreation initiatives
- Assist in the developing, planning, and implementing campus recreational activities
- Supervise and disciple campus recreation student leadership staff
- Organize, manage and facilitate intramurals with use of IM Leagues platform
- Meet 1-1 regularly with the Student Success Specialist for Student Engagement
- Partner with the HCU Bradshaw Fitness Center staff for collaborative initiatives
- Assist the Department of Student Life with department initiatives as a department staff member.
- Attend campus recreation events and intramurals
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree is required.
- Enrollment in a graduate program at Houston Christian University during the entire GA position.
- AACCA safety certification. *Can be obtained after hire
- First-Aid/Athletic training experience preferred.
- Organized – able to handle multiple priorities simultaneously.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Work to further the university's vision as stated in the "Ten Core Convictions."
- Be available for night and weekend activities and events.
- Exhibit an active Christian faith.
