Student Government Association (SGA) Executive Board Description

Elected Positions: SGA President, Vice President, and Vice President of Records

Appointed Positions: Director of Finance and Director of Public Relations

Executive Branch Application Process: to be considered for the elected positions of SGA, you must apply through the HCU Leadership Common Application. All qualified applicants will be sent a secondary application and asked to provide information detailing their desire for the position. If selected, applicants will then interview with the Elections Committee in SGA and once approved, proceed with the campuswide elections process.

Qualifications:

- A demonstrated consistent willingness to serve students.
- Demonstrate an active Christian faith.
- Ability to relate to peers and have maturity to serve as a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions toward others.
- Remain in good standing with HCU.
- Demonstrate organizational skills.
- Support University policies and procedures.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.5.

Expectations:

- Attend all SGA meetings (both assembly and executive), training sessions, events, and retreats.
- Coordinate outside commitments to maintain SGA responsibilities.
- Attend any end of year celebrations and trainings (unless you have a communicated class absence).
- Attend the Commissioning Banquet on August, 19th and one additional training day, date is to be determined but will be in August, 2025.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with planning and implementing of SGA events, programs, and initiatives (i.e., Opal Goolsby, HCU Administrative meetings, Town Halls, etc.).
- Establish and strengthen connections and collaborations with HCU student organizations, departments, and colleges/schools.
- Provide encouragement and motivation to fellow organization members.
- SPB presence: one SGA Executive Officer to attend the Student Programming Board meeting once per month
- Intentionally connect with students to understand the needs and wants of the student body.
- Ensure that all events meet HCU standards and purposefully connect with different parts of the student body.
- Help recruit and maintain relationships with SGA Assembly Members.
- Prepare and file any report required.
