Purpose Statement

Criteria of Eligibility for Membership

- Enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 semester hours)
- Sophomore, Junior or Senior undergraduate student during 2025-26 school year who demonstrates leadership ability
- Desires to promote Houston Christian University at student, donor, alumni, faculty, and staff activities
- Must be able to purchase items for the uniform. (Jacket, polo and other accessories will be provided.)
- Maintains academic excellence (minimum of 3.0 GPA)
- · Each member must attend monthly meeting
- All members must attend an on-campus retreat prior to the start of the academic year
- Each semester, members must sign up to help at events hosted by the Office of the President,

Alumni Relations, and Advancement Benefits of Membership in Good Standing

- Each member in good standing shall assist at a variety of events as a representative of the Office of the President, on behalf of the entire student body to University Friends.
- Each member shall be invited to student leader trainings and receptions when they are held.
- Each Student Foundation member in good standing shall be recognized at Honors Convocation.

Seniors will be recognized with a certificate, presented by the President of HCU.
