

Summer Launch Mentor

Job Description: Summer Launch is a week-long program designed to prepare incoming freshmen for the academic, social, and cultural rigors of college life. Mentor positions are available for general students and the STEM track. The STEM track within Summer Launch has been traditionally called HuskySteps. Summer Launch mentors are assigned a cohort of freshmen, host a small group daily, stay overnight in the dorms, and participate in all activities and off-campus excursions.

Mandatory Dates:

- Summer Launch Program: June 23 – 27, 2025
- Summer Launch Spring Training: TBA
- Mentor Training: June 22, beginning at 1pm

Compensation: \$500 stipend after program

Job Responsibilities:

- Ability to mentor and guide incoming freshmen
- Display a leadership role during activities and on excursions
- Work closely with Summer Launch staff to ensure the program runs smoothly
- Support staff/faculty and model appropriate behavior
- Use critical thinking and place student wellness at the forefront of all interactions
- Sleep overnight in the HCU residence halls
- Assist in planning and coordinating program activities
- Host daily small group with attendees
- Participate in all weekly activities

Position Requirements: The desired candidate will be intentional, organized, and able to make authentic connections; maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA (3.0 preferred); adherence to HCU Code of Conduct and remain in good standing at the university; preference is given to students who have previously attended Summer Launch
