BILLING PAYMENT OPTIONS AND EXPLANATIONS

Financial Settlement is the process to finalize your financial obligation each semester.

Late registration: students registering on or after the first of class will pay a \$250 late registration fee.

There are two payment options available outlined below. You may pay online via Touchnet (payment portal) or at the Cashier's Office. Touchnet accepts ACH (electronic check), credit and debit card.

OPTION 1 – PAYMENT IN FULL

You may pay your first bill in full by the first day of class for the desired semester. Students may pay online via Touchnet or at the Cashier's Office if paying in full by credit, debit or check. You can contact the Cashier's Office via email: cashier@hbu.edu or phone: (281) 649-3471.

OPTION 2 – SEMESTER PAYMENT PLANS

You may enroll in a payment plan at the time you register. However, it is encouraged to enroll after your financial aid is fully authorized which can be verified in Touchnet. If you receive additional financial aid after enrolling, please email cashier@hbu.edu to recalculate your plan. There is a \$50 enrollment fee per term. The enrollment fee increases to \$75 after the 12th day of class. Payment plans are not available during the Summer term(s). Students and families can set up their payment plan as follows:

ADDITIONAL FINANCING OPTIONS

Online Scholarships – Apply for online scholarships from outside agencies. A list of suggested resources is available on the FAO website.

Federal Work Study – An opportunity to earn wages to help meet the cost of education. The amount a student may earn is determined by financial aid eligibility, the hours worked, and the hourly wage.

Parent PLUS Loans - Available to parents of undergraduate dependent students to help cover educational expenses (up to the student's cost of attendance minus financial aid). Houston Baptist will begin accepting PLUS Loan applications June 1. The application can be completed at StudentAid.gov.

Private Loans - Students may apply for a private loan through outside lenders. Lenders may require credit worthy co-signers before final approval. Students may borrow up to the cost of attendance minus financial aid. HBU will begin accepting private loan applications for the 2023-2024 academic year on June 1. A list of lenders HBU frequently works with is available on the FAO website. When applying for a private loan, consider applying with a credit-worthy cosigner to help keep your interest rate lower.
