



Retention of Undergraduate Students Fall 2008 to Fall 2009

Executive Summary

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of undergraduate students enrolled in the Fall 2008 term. Using the Banner system, students were classified as enrolled, withdrawn, or graduated for Fall 2009. Those classified as graduated received their degrees in Fall 2008, Spring 2009, or Summer 2009. The tables that follow look at four different (but overlapping) cohorts of students: all undergraduates, new freshmen, new freshmen who were provisionally admitted, and new transfer students.

The overall retention rate for undergraduates who did not graduate remained at seventy-four percent. For new freshmen, the retention rate is 72.3%, up significantly from last year's rate of 70.4%. However, the retention rate for new transfers dropped nearly 10%; reasons for this are unknown. The retention rate for provisional admits also dropped, but large swings are not uncommon with small groups of students like the provisionals. The retention rate for Juniors and Seniors still remains below 80% after adjusting for graduates. These students have the most invested in the university, and their rate should be much higher than the 71.4% of Freshmen and Sophomores. Additional analysis and study is needed to shed more light on these retention patterns.

Main Report

This report tracks the enrollment patters of the 2,182 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2008 who were classified Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors. Students who entered in Summer 2008 were counted as new students (either freshman or transfer) in Fall 2008 as well. Twenty-six postbaccalaureate students from the total undergraduate enrollment of 2,208 have been excluded.

Retention percentages for the various cohorts for Fall 2008 to Fall 2009 are below. Also included are the data from previous years for comparison.

Of the 2,182 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2008:

- 291 (13.4%) graduated in December 2008, May 2009, or August 2009
- 490 (22.5%) did not return for Fall 2009
- 1,401 (64.2%) reenrolled for Fall 2009

After adjusting for graduates, the undergraduate retention rate was 74.1%. See Section 1, page 3, for more details.

Of the 560 new freshmen enrolled in Fall 2008:

- 155 (27.7%) did not return for Fall 2009
- 405 (72.3%) reenrolled for Fall 2008

The retention rate for new freshmen was 72.3%. See Section 2, page 7 for more details.

Of the 36 new provisionally admitted students in Fall 2008:

- 16 (44.4%) did not return for Fall 2009
- 20 (55.6%) reenrolled for Fall 2009

The retention rate for new provisionally admitted students was 55.6%. See Section 3, page 11 for more details.

Of the 252 new transfer students in Fall 2008:

- 0 (0.0%) graduated in December 2008, May 2009, or August 2009
- 111 (44.0%) did not return for Fall 2009
- 141 (56.0%) reenrolled for Fall 2008

After adjusting for graduates, the retention rate for new transfers was 56.0%. See Section 4, page 15, for more details.

The four sections of this report focus on the four cohorts listed above. Retention patterns are displayed by gender, ethnicity, minority status, citizenship, test score ranges, high school quartiles, residency (on- or off-campus and county), and college.

Please note that in the tables that follow, "Withdrawn" does not refer to students who have gone through an official withdrawal process with the University. It refers to students who have not graduated and who have not enrolled for the Fall 2009 term.
