

Undergraduate Teacher Certification Process

Students seeking Texas teacher certification as part of their undergraduate degree program must be admitted to the HBU Educator Preparation Program (EPP).

BEFORE EPP ADMISSION
Complete a minimum of 45 course hours
Submit a completed electronic EPP application via TaskStream by the deadline: Fall admission (deadline is September 15)Spring admission (deadline is February 15)
Upload <u>all transcripts</u> where courses were taken for college/university credit
Have a minimum cumulative GPA or last 60 hours GPA of 2.75 or higher on all college/university course work attempted
Complete course prerequisites during the first 45 hours of HBU coursework with a "C" or better in each course: • EDUC 2320 Learning and Development; and • EDUC 2330 Foundations of American Educational Thought
Pass all sections of the THEA exam (scores: Reading 230, Math 230, Writing 220)
Demonstrate Reading proficiency via SAT Verbal 550, ACT Rdg 22, THEA Reading 230, or completion of ENGL 2315 or ENGL 2325 with a "C" or better
Demonstrate Math proficiency via completion of MATH 1305 or MATH 1313 with a "C" or better
Demonstrate Writing proficiency via completion of ENGL 1320 and ENGL 1330 with a "C" or better in each course
Demonstrate Speech competency via completion of COMM 1323 with a "C" or better, <u>or</u> submit the Speech Competency form signed by an HBU professor
Successfully pass the EPP Admission Interview
Demonstrate English Oral Proficiency
Provide written confirmation of admission acceptance as directed by the CPPE Director
AFTER EPP ADMISSION
Observe <u>all</u> guidelines outlined in the EPP Handbook
Complete degree plan coursework with a 2.5 GPA and "C" or better (or "D" in non-EPP courses), including a "B" or better in EDUC 4301/4311 and supplemental courses
Submit applications for Clinical Teaching and graduation two (2) semesters prior
Pass a national criminal history check as required by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). A conviction or deferred adjudication may result in ineligibility for Texas issue of a educator certificate. The candidate may request a Preliminary Criminal History Evaluation from TEA if there is reason to believe ineligibility may occur due to a prior conviction
Pass required Content and PPR exam(s)
Complete Clinical Teaching (1 semester; unpaid student)
Apply and pay for a Standard certificate
